Costa and Garmson (1994) have developed

Mediating Tools:

- During planning, mentors mediate by helping their mentees:
- Clarify lesson’s goals, determine evidence of student’s achievement
- Describe the lesson’s relationship to the actual and/or hypothetical curriculum
- Anticipate teaching strategies and decisions
- Anticipate any concerns
- Identify the mentor’s data-gathering focus and procedures
- During reflecting, mentors mediate by helping their protégés:
- Summarize their impressions and assessments of the lesson
- Recall data supporting those impressions and assessments
- Compare planned with performed teaching decisions and student learning
