

DISSEMINATION EVENTS IN HUNGARY

ESL workshops:

Tempus Public Foundation organised 9 workshops focused on early school leaving from March 2016 to June 2017. Target groups of the workshops were teachers, school leaders, service providers (from Pedagogical Education Centres, Family support and child care services, Municipal guardianship offices, School Maintenance Centres, Professional Pedagogical Services and Pedagogical Institutes). On the ESL related workshops 18 external experts presented or facilitated at all.

1. Apple on the tree – Focus on early school leaving – Károly Leiner: My children (Presentation of the book and adaptation of its case studies)

The workshop was organised on 31 March 2016 in Budapest with 22 participants who were mostly teachers, school leaders and service providers. The program focused on case studies from the book „My children” of the special needs educator and therapist Károly Lerner. Károly Lerner therapist introduced the case studies from the publication.

2. Apple on the tree – Focus on early school leaving – Bullying. Is bullying exist in the school or even in the kindergarten?

The workshop was organised on 28 April 2016 with 44 participants (teachers, school leaders, service providers). The main theme of the event was bullying in educational institutions. Three external experts presented about bullying. Katalin Parti scientific worker from the The National Institute of Criminology presented the Hungarian background of bullying. Éva Jármí psychologist presented about methods and programs against bullying. Gábor Szalánczy; project leader of a Comenius bullying & media presented the achievements of the project.

3. Apple on the tree – Focus on early school leaving – Bullying - 2nd workshop

The workshop was organised on 02 June 2016. On the event there were 55 participants (teachers, school leaders, service providers). Two facilitators held a mini training where efficient tools were shown for handling bullying in school.

4. Apple on the tree – Focus on early school leaving – Career guidance

The workshop was organised on 22 September 2016 with three external experts. Miklós Kenderfi from the Szent István University had presented about career guidance in Hungary, then two facilitators held parallel practice-oriented mini-trainings. On the event there were 50 participants; mostly teachers, school leaders, service providers.

5. Apple on the tree – Focus on early school leaving – Conflict resolution with communication methods

The workshop was organised on 27 October 2016 with 62 participants (teachers, school leaders, service providers). After the presentation about the theme in Hungarian level two parallel practice-oriented mini-trainings were held.

6. Apple on the tree – Focus on early school leaving – Early warning systems

The workshop was organised on 24 November 2016. On the event there were 28 participants (teachers, school leaders, service providers). Eszter Szegedi the leader of the CroCooS project had presented about early warning systems. Two facilitators held a practice-oriented mini-training focusing on case studies.

7. Apple on the tree – Focus on early school leaving – Tools and good practices for preventing early school leaving

The workshop was organised on 23 February 2017 with 45 participants (teachers, school leaders, service providers). On the event besides the two presentations about the ESL related projects of Tempus Public Foundation two parallel practice-oriented mini-workshops were held.

8. Apple on the tree – Focus on early school leaving – Resilience development and emotional education against early school leaving

The workshop was organised on 30 March 2017 with 32 participants (teachers, school leaders, service providers). On the event Csilla Szabó the project coordinator of ESLplus project had presented about ESL related activities of TPF, then two parallel practice-oriented mini-trainings were held by two external experts.

9. Apple on the tree – Focus on early school leaving – Tools for supporting the development of early warning systems

The workshop was organised in 16 June 2017 with three external experts and 44 participants. The workshop was dedicated to service providers from Pedagogical Educational Centres. Besides on the event there were service providers from other institutions, teachers and school leaders. After two presentations focusing on early warning systems and educational institutions two parallel practice-oriented mini-trainings had been held.

Other dissemination events:

Spring Pedagogical Day

The event was organised by the Pedagogical Education Centre of Miskolc on 13 April 2016. The main theme of the event dedicated for teachers and school leaders were talent care and compensations for disadvantages. At the 2nd part of the program in the section “Compensation for disadvantages” Csilla Szabó ESLplus project leader presented on the ESLplus project.

Tools for reducing dropout in VET institutions

The main themes of the conference held on 09 June 2016, Szolnok were the strategic aims for reducing dropout and presenting good practices in the field of early school leaving. Emese Abari Ibolya CroCooS project leader presented the ESL-related projects at Tempus Public Foundation. She talked about the CroCooS and the ESLplus projects.

Conference for reducing dropout in the education – “HASÍT” Opening Conference

The conference was organised at the University of Dunaújváros in Hungary in the framework of “The Week of Science in 2016” on 07 November 2016. Bertalan Péter Farkas the leader of the CroCooS project gave a talk about tools for reducing early school leaving. He presented on the CroCooS and the ESLplus projects which are the ESL-related projects managed by Tempus Public Foundation.

Conference for reducing dropout in the education – “HASÍT” Final Conference

The conference was organised at the University of Dunaújváros in Hungary on 30 May 2017. Bertalan Péter Farkas the leader of the CroCooS project presented about the tools in the CroCooS project for reducing dropout.

Conference Tackling early school leaving in Europe and in Hungary

The conference was organised on 04 June 2015 on the basis of the launching the Tackling Early Leaving from Education and Training in Europe publication. Eszter Szegedi project leader presented about CroCooS project efforts and tools for tackling this issue.

Eszter Szegedi project leader presented on CroCooS results, efforts and tools for prevention early school leaving and showing the institutionalization model of implementing an early warning system in educational institutions at the Hungarian School Health Association Conference (05 October 2015).

Hungarian National Pedagogical Conference

Led by Eszter Szegedi project leader the Hungarian CroCooS partnership held a symposium on Early school leaving – social and economic aspects and conception of a launching European policy experimentation project, between 6-8 November 2015.
